

MAGNET AND PERMITS WITH TRANSPORTATION

WHAT IS IT?

Court ordered voluntary integration program. District transportation is provided to eligible students.

WHO CAN APPLY?

All students, grade K-11, who live within the boundaries of the LAUSD are eligible to apply to and attend an LAUSD Magnet. This includes English Language Learners, Special Education and Gifted and Talented Students.

HOW DO I APPLY?

The CHOICES Brochure is mailed to the home of every LAUSD student. The brochure is also accessible at all LAUSD schools, district offices and LA City Libraries. The application is submitted to the Office of Student Integration Services, Beaudry, 25th floor.

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

Brochures are available at the beginning of November.

IS THERE A DEADLINE?

The forms are due on the last day of school in December.

INTRODUCTION TO ENROLLMENT AND TRANSFER OPTIONS

INTRA-DISTRICT (LAUSD SCHOOL TO LAUSD SCHOOL) PERMITS

WHAT IS IT?

Permits may be granted for students to attend another school within the boundaries of LAUSD. These permits are based on parent employment, safety and protection, childcare, specialized program, senior status (5th, 8th, or 12th grade), or continuing enrollment.

WHO CAN APPLY?

All LAUSD students are eligible to apply.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Paper applications are available at all LAUSD school sites or can be obtained online at studentpermits.lausd.net.

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

Beginning March 1st each year.

LAUSD OPEN ENROLLMENT

WHAT IS IT?

Enables an LAUSD student to be able to apply to any regular, grade appropriate LAUSD public school that has seats designated for open enrollment.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any LAUSD students may apply to an LAUSD school with identified available space.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Application forms are available at the school site. The form must be signed by an administrator at the school of residence and the requested school. The list of schools is available at lausd.net in May of each year.

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

May 3rd

June 1st

SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES

WHAT IS IT?

Program designed to improve educational options and increase professional training to support the development of youth that qualify for gifted and talented education (GATE) programs.

WHO CAN APPLY?

LAUSD students in K-11 grade and are identified as GATE or high ability with appropriate documentation are eligible to apply.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Parent must apply directly to the requested school. To view a list of SAS schools please visit www.lausd.k12.ca.us/lausd/offices/GATE/prog-opt-3.html

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

Late March or early April.

NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND: PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE

WHAT IS IT?

Authorized in the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB), the district offers NCLB-PSC to parents of all student enrolled at a program improvement (PI) school. These students will have an option to transfer to a non PI school.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students who are currently attending a PI school or a school at risk of being placed in PI status.

HOW DO I APPLY?

The CHOICES Brochure is mailed to the home of every LAUSD student. The brochure is also available at all LAUSD schools, district offices and LA City Libraries. The application is submitted to the Office of Student Integration Services, Beaudry, 25th floor.

Brochures are available at the beginning of November.

IS THERE A DEADLINE?

The forms are due on the last day of school in December.

INTER-DISTRICT (DISTRICT TO DISTRICT) PERMITS

WHAT IS IT?

Permits may be granted for students to attend a school in another district. These permits have specific criteria:

- ◆ *Outgoing* permits are based on parent employment, specialized program, or continuing enrollment for senior high school students.
- ◆ *Incoming* permits are based on parent employment, safety and protection, childcare, specialized program, senior status (5th, 8th, or 12th grade), or continuing enrollment.

WHO CAN APPLY?

All LAUSD students are eligible to apply, however specific permit criteria must be met.

HOW DO I APPLY?

The online application is available at studentpermits.lausd.net.

Paper applications will not be accepted.

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

March 1st

IS THERE A DEADLINE?

April 30th for outgoing permit applications only. There is no deadline for incoming permits.

ROMERO OPEN ENROLLMENT ACT

WHAT IS IT?

Parents of eligible students may request another school that has a higher Academic Performance Index (API) score within the LAUSD or within another school district.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students attending one of the 1,000 Open Enrollment schools. To find out if your school is eligible and to find a school with a higher API visit www.cde.ca.gov/sp/eo/op/

HOW DO I APPLY?

An online application must be submitted online at romerotransfer.lausd.net

WHEN CAN I APPLY FOR THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR?

The online application period will begin on November 1st to come into LAUSD schools. Each school district has their own process.

IS THERE A DEADLINE?

January 1st each year.
